

YHS-ART01 Guan Gong Sculpture

This Guan Gong sculpture named "Fearless"., his right hand is raised aloft with his palm facing upward to represent "Shun Tian", while his left-hand punches downward in allusion to "Ying Di", both of which mean obey nature. At the same time, he is shouting "be brave without fear". In Chinese martial arts, the palm represents "literature", while the fist represents "martial arts". Therefore, this work represents Guan Gong's "integrity of literature and martial arts, inheritance of loyalty and righteousness".
